Description of Duties: Teaching Assistants (ages 15+) will assist students and teachers in IS183's summer camp classrooms; lead selected group activities; help set up, present, and distribute family surveys at weekly student art shows; and assist with various coordination duties under the supervision of the Camp Coordinator and Program Director.

Learning Outcomes: Teaching Assistants will gain non-profit organizational experience and receive on-the-job training in classroom management, visual arts techniques and skills.

Skills/Competencies Required: Preference is based upon availability and experience, and is given to high school students, college students and those considering an art education career. Ideal applicants have experience working with children in a camp setting, experience in the visual arts, and an interest in art education. Teaching Assistants will be expected to supervise students in specific age groups ranging from 6–14 years and interact with parents, staff, faculty, and fellow interns, so strong interpersonal skills are a must. Candidates should have attended camp before and/or have demonstrated significant prior experience in similar programs, or have interest in education and art. Ability to drive is preferred (transportation required).
